5. Feedback committee also prepared different questionnaires on syllabus transactions for students, teachers and alumni in online mode.

Details about the various feedbacks taken by the feedback committee of the college are as follows:

1. Parents feedback

Parents feedback about the college, teachers, infrastructure and other facilities has been taken in online mode and analysed. A total of 91 responses have been received. About 93.5% of parents have given feedback as “Best and Excellent” about the campus/ infrastructure of the college. About 85.7% of parents have given feedback as “Best and Excellent” about the work culture in the college. About 83.6% of parents have given feedback as “Best and Excellent” about the teaching staff of the college. About 78% of parents have given feedback as “Best and Excellent” about the non-teaching staff of the college. About 89% of parents have given the feedback as “Best and Excellent” about library facilities available in the college. About 83.6% of parents have given feedback as “Best and Excellent” about the educational course and facilities available in the college. About 84.7% of parents have given feedback as “Best and Excellent” about the cleanliness of the college. About 83.6% of parents have given the feedback as “Best and Excellent” about sports facilities available in the college. About 83.6% of parents have given feedback as “Best and Excellent” about programs and extracurricular activities organised in the college. About 81.4% of parents have given the feedback as “Best and Excellent” about placement and career guidance in the college. 2. Alumni Feedback

3. Students feedback on Syllabus and its Transaction (Curriculum)

Students online feedback on the syllabus and its transaction have been taken in online mode and analysed. A total of 93 responses have been received. About 81% of students have given the feedback as “Strongly agree and agree” about the Syllabus is need-based. About 87% of students have given the feedback as “Strongly agree and agree” about the Syllabus is suitable for the course. About 73% of students have given the feedback as “Strongly agree and agree” about the Syllabus is sufficient to bridge the gap between industry standards /current global scenarios and academics. About 69% of students have given the feedback as “Strongly agree and agree” about the rating of the Size of the syllabus in terms of the load on the student. About 76% of students have given the feedback as “Strongly agree and agree” about the course/syllabus has a good balance between theory and application. About 78% of students have given the feedback as “Strongly agree and agree” about the course/syllabus has made interest in the subject area. About 75% of students have given the feedback as “Strongly agree and agree” about rating the relevance of the units in the Syllabus relevant to the course. About 76% of students have given the feedback as “Strongly agree and agree” about the rating of the courses regarding Laboratory experiments. About 78% of students have given the feedback as “Strongly agree and agree” about the Syllabus Creating of interest to pursue higher education. About 75% of students have given the feedback a “Strongly agree and agree” rating for the evaluation scheme designed for each of the courses. About 75% of students have given the feedback as “Strongly agree and agree” about the syllabus Weightage given to Employability / Entrepreneurship.

4. Teachers feedback on syllabus and its Transaction

Teachers online feedback on the syllabus and its transaction has been taken in online mode and analysed. A total of 18 responses have been received. About 72.2%

of teachers have given the feedback as “Strongly agree and agree” about the syllabus is need-based. About 83.3% of teachers have given the feedback as “Strongly agree and agree” about the syllabus is suitable for the course. About 55.5% of teachers have given the feedback as “Strongly agree and Agree” about the syllabus is sufficient to bridge the gap between industry standards / current global scenarios and academics. About 88.9% of teachers have given the feedback as “Strongly agree and agree” about the Aims and objectives of the syllabi are well-defined and clear. About 72.2% of teachers have given the feedback as “Strongly agree and agree” about the course/ syllabus has a good balance between theory and application. About 77.8% of teachers have given the feedback as “Strongly agree and agree” about the course/ syllabus has made interest in the subject area. About 72.2% of teachers have given the feedback as “Strongly agree and agree” about the timely coverage of the syllabus is possible in the mentioned number of hours. About 83.3% of teachers have given feedback as “Strongly agree and Agree” about the designed experiments stimulate the interest of students in the subject and deepen their understanding through relating theory to practice (Experiential learning). About 83.4% of teachers have given feedback as “Strongly agree and Agree” about the practicals enable to develop the experimental design, problem-solving and analysis skills of the students. About 72.2% of teachers have given the feedback as “Strongly agree and Agree” about the mechanism used for development/revision of curriculum by BOS is well in place.

5. Alumni feedback on the syllabus and its Transaction

Alumni feedback on the syllabus and its transaction has been taken in online mode and analysed. A total of 24 responses have been received. About 79.16% of alumni have given “Excellent and Very Good” feedback regarding the Weightage given to the syllabus for fulfilling their expectations. About 75% of alumni have given “Excellent and Very Good” feedback regarding the Calibre of students passing out of this University. About 83.33% of alumni have given “Excellent and Very Good” feedback regarding How do they rate the course related to employability. About 66.66% of alumni have given “Excellent and Very Good” feedback regarding How do they rate the course related to entrepreneurship. About 75% of the alumni have given

“Excellent and Very Good” feedback regarding the Weightage given to practical and fieldwork components. About 66.66% of the alumni have given “Excellent and Very Good” feedback regarding How do they rate the learning experience in terms of their relevance to the real-life application. About 66.66% of the alumni have given “Excellent and Very Good” feedback regarding How do they rate the courses that they have learned in relation to their current job.

6. Employer feedback on syllabus and its Transaction

Employer feedback on the syllabus and its transaction has been taken in online mode and analysed. A total of 05 responses have been received. About 100% of alumni have given “Excellent and Very Good” feedback regarding the Relevance of the program/course in the view of industrial application. About 80% of alumni have given “Excellent and Very Good” feedback regarding the curriculum having a good balance between theory and applications. About 80% of alumni have given “Excellent and Very Good” feedback regarding the curriculum having enough content for a student to acquire sufficient knowledge to secure a subject-related job. About 100% of alumni have given “Excellent and Very Good” feedback regarding the syllabus having content for developing skills to handle problems at the workplace. About 80% of the alumni have given “Excellent and Very Good” feedback regarding the curriculum providing scope for acquiring employable and entrepreneurship skills. About 100% of the alumni have given “Excellent and Very Good” feedback regarding the applicability of the domains and the tools used for designing the experiments in terms of existing practices in the industry. About 100% of the alumni have given “Excellent and Very Good” feedback regarding the experiments in terms of their relevance to real-life applications. About 100% of the alumni have given “Excellent and Very Good” feedback regarding the proficiency of our students working with you. About 100% of the alumni have given “Excellent and Very Good” feedback regarding the relevance of the programme in the view of self-employment.
