1. Title

Energy Audit of Educational Institutes

2. Objectives

- a. To aware the students of the College about participation in the Project.
- b. To select the interested students of the College for internship under MoU for conducting Energy audit of the Institutes
- c. To impart the knowledge of fundamental Concepts of Energy Audit and prevention measures.
- d. To organize workshop, Group Discussion on the concerned subject.
- e. To provide the technical support to the students so that they can perform the energy audit independently.
- f. To learn about writing of the energy audit report.

3. The Context

Recently, the use of electrical energy is increase beyond the limit. So there is a need to save the energy at the priority. Energy Audit is the significant way for the management of energy and its conservation. Energy audit provides pattern of energy consumption, to identify the potential areas for energy optimization and recommendations for energy conservation. An energy audit study is a joint exercise of PPS and institute to account and contain energy usage. In this project, selected students will acquire the knowledge of fundamentals of the electrical appliances and their wattage. Overall survey of the appliances and energy consumption in the institute will conduct. Analysis of the collected data will be completed and report with recommendations would be submitted.

4. The Practice

After Introduction of the project into the classes, three interested students of B.Sc. third year Physics have been selected for the internship in the project. Importance of the electrical energy, wattage of the appliances, consumption and energy conservation methods have been explained and demonstrated the technical support for the proper energy audit. It was shown that the energy audit will identify energy-saving opportunities, how it will help to understand energy usage and ways to use energy better. It can identify safety concerns with electrical systems, wiring, and ventilation, thus making the institute or home safer. Selected students with Expert Engineers of PPE completed the energy audit of the college first and then perform the energy audit of other nearby institutes. Students completed the internship, became expert and received the certificate.

5. Evidence of Success

Students participated in the process of energy audit and acquired the knowledge of wattage, consumption and conservation of energy. Students initially completed the audit of the college with expert engineers of PPS and then perform the audit of other institutes independently done by the students observed and monitored by the coordinator and experts of the PPS. After completing the internship and going through the viva voce of the students, completion certificates issued by the PPS, Pune.

6. Problems Encountered and Resources required

The problem of selection was solved by proper cancelling of the students in the classes. Three students participated enthusiastically and completed the internship in the project Energy Audit with reference to MoU with PPS.


