The college received the NAAC accreditation on 31-12-2009 as 'B' grade with CGPA of 2.95. The IQAC of the college came into existence in the month of Feb 2009. The first meeting of IQAC was held on 4/03/2010. The following parameters were decided for quality assurance in this meeting.
